BASIC REVIEW OBJECTIVES

The paper must be original and cannot be already published or sent for review/publication to another journal or similar vehicle. Author(s) must wait for final answer of JISOM editorial board, accepted / rejected submission, before being able to submit it to another journal.

The paper will be sent to (at least) three reviewers, without authoring information.

The reviewers will evaluate and submit their considerations for each paper taking into accounts the following check points:

- Relevance
- Originality
- Significance / usefulness
- Technical soundness
- Bibliographical references
- Presentation
- Linguistic quality (English fluency and consistence)

If the reviewers ask for a revised version of the paper, the authors should make revisions alongside the requests of the reviewers and send the modified paper no later than the designated deadline. The paper may be then accepted or rejected, based on the revised version.

If the reviewers accept or reject a paper, their decision is final.
